

Kumaraswami Kamaraj, commonly known as K. Kamaraj, earned the title of "King Maker" due to his significant role in shaping Indian politics and his influence in the selection of the Prime Minister of India. Here are some key factors that contributed to Kamaraj's rise and his reputation as a kingmaker:

Political career: Kamaraj had a long and successful political career, starting from his early involvement in the Indian independence movement. He joined the Indian National Congress and became a prominent leader in the state of Tamil Nadu (formerly known as Madras State). His grassroots organizing skills, dedication, and astute political acumen helped him rise within the Congress party ranks.

Organizational abilities: Kamaraj was renowned for his exceptional organizational skills and his ability to mobilize people. He focused on strengthening the party at the grassroots level, building a robust network of workers and volunteers.

There are various areas where one can work. The employment areas for horticulture or as follows:




